**ORDER**

The Court comes before the Court by way of Plaintiff Jackeline Martinez-Santiago's letter request [Docket Item 76] to lift the 90-day Order for Stay Pending Mediation in this case, which this Court entered on November 24, 2014 [Docket Item 65], in order to allow parties the opportunity to achieve a negotiated resolution. Plaintiff reports that the parties' mediation on January 26, 2015 was unsuccessful, and Plaintiff does not anticipate being able to resolve the matter in the time remaining in the stay.
